

KANPUR: An elderly farmer, who was axed at by his drunken son on Monday night, succumbed to his injury during treatment at the LLR Hospital here late on Tuesday night. On the complaint of his younger son Santosh, police have lodged the report and launched raids to nab the assailant. Balvir Singh (57) of the village, under the Kakwan police station had two sons Pappu and Santosh. On Monday night, when the elder son Pappu returned home in a drunken state after selling the stolen grain in the market, Balvir Singh slapped him and made him out of the house. After some time, Pappu again returned home and attacked on Balvir Singh with the axe when he was having dinner. Profusely bleeding Balvir Singh was immediately taken to the primary health centre where doctors referred him for the LLR

Hospital, Kanpur. During treatment, he succumbed to his injury late on Tuesday night.

KILLED : Due to wrong injection given by a quack, a woman succumbed to her illness in Shambhuwa village, under the Vidhnu police station on Wednesday. Munni Devi along with daughter Kanak had gone to consult Dr Kamlesh Yadav at his medical store for the treatment of her grand daughter (14). After her treatment, Munni Devi also asked the doctor to examine her. On this, without examining her blood pressure, doctor gave an injection to Munni Devi. Immediately after giving her the injection, the condition of Munni Devi started deteriorating when the doctor gave another injection to her. When he failed to control the situation, he asked her family members to immediately take her to Kanpur. While being taken to

Kanpur, Munni Devi succumbed to her illness on the way. Thereafter, villagers staged agitation at the medical store of Dr Kamlesh Yadav with the body and pressed for initiating penal action against the quack.

TALK DELIVERED : Arvind Gupta, a renowned toy inventor and a Padmashree awardee delivered a talk at IIT-Kanpur as part of the Institute Lecture Series organised by the Dean of Research & Development. In his lecture, he used several simple toys made by folding paper, discarded straws, juice boxes etc. to demonstrate scientific principles like centrifugal force, gravity and electromagnetism. He also shared his experience of working with students and being inspired by their curiosity to invent more such toys.

An alumnus of IIT-Kanpur, he is known all over the world for using simple

toys and experiments to help children understand science better. He also stressed on the fact that schools should not try to limit children's creativity by rote learning. 'Children should be allowed to break things and then put them back together, to tinker, to experiment, to learn by 'doing' and this is what will really help campaigns like 'Make in India', he added.

The theme for this year's meeting was 'Harnessing the potential of modern technology for sustainable agriculture'. The event was graced by Governor Ram Naik. One can lead healthy life with slight modification

Noted cardiologist, Dr Abhineet Gupta while addressing Nutritional Health talks at the CSJM University said there was a sharp rise in heart attacks for people less than 50 years and this was on account of several factors including modern lifestyle. He said with slight modification of one can lead a near healthy life. He said making lifestyle changes was a proven method. He said although there were no guarantees that a heart-healthy lifestyle will keep heart disease away, it will certainly improve health in many ways. He advised people to give up smoking and said smokers had more than twice the chance of having a heart attack as non-smokers. He said if one smoked, one must quit immediately. He said nonsmokers who were exposed to passive smoke also had increased risk. He advised that eliminating exposure to smoke was important. He also advised people to ensure they improved their cholesterol and the chance of having heart disease increased as ones total amount of cholesterol increased. He said total goal should be

less than 200 mg/dl. Your HDL, the good cholesterol, should be higher than 40 mg/dl for men and higher than 50 mg/dl for woman (and the higher the better). He said besides LDL, the bad cholesterol, should be less than 130 mg/dl. He said it was important to note that cholesterol values meant different things to different people. He said the difference depended on ones own odds of having heart disease.

Dr Gupta said a diet low in cholesterol, saturated and trans fat, and simple sugars will help lower cholesterol levels and reduce chances of having heart disease. He also advised regular exercise too help lower 'bad' cholesterol and raise 'good' cholesterol.

IMA-K ELECTIONS: The Chairman of the Election Committee, Dr SK Katiyar while addressing the presspersons on Wednesday said the elections for IMA-Kanpur will be held on September 30. He said this year also the elections will be held through EVMs for full transparency and to ensure that the results were declared at the earliest. He said IMA-Kanpur happened to be the first

will hold elections through EVM. He said the committee had been ensuring free and fair elections for the past three years. He said as per the decision of the meeting the process of filing nomination will be between September 5 and 12. He said the withdrawal date was September 15 and said the voting will be on a Sunday and between 9 am and 5 pm.
