HEALTH CAMP HELD:

A health check-up camp was organised at IMA Bhavan on Thursday. Patients were examined for various health problems, mental disorders and blood sugar. Dr Chiranjeev Prasad from Ursala Hospital told that the majority of the patients who came to him suffered from depression and anxiety. He said there is a lot of aggressiveness in patients due to summer season and patients often suffer from mood swings. He added that people are turning anxious and mostly suffer from lack of

sleep. Dr. Mehroz Akhtar, Medical Officer, Kashi Ram Hospital said that she was diagnosing people for general illness, diabetes, hypertension and stroke. She said that she was giving them necessary medicines and even referring them to tertiary hospitals for follow up. She said that the common problems suffered by the patients included fever, general weakness, joint and muscular pain, high BP and raised blood sugar, joint pain and piles. She said that patients are counselled on life style modification and are given diet charts. She said that besides this preventive measures are explained to the patients. She informed that patients who are diagnosed with diabetes and high blood pressure are given medicines

and are referred to Kashi Ram Hospital, NCD (Non Communicable Disease) clinic for further investigation. She said that the most frequent problems by the patients were diabetes with high BP. She said that she was expecting more than 200 patients in the health camp.
