

Smog in Kanpur

ground-level ozone problems existed in many major cities around the world. He said as per studies carried out in Kanpur half of all residents lived in areas where the smog was so bad that pollution levels routinely exceeded safety standards. He said smog was made up of a combination of air pollutants that can compromise human health, harm the environment, and even cause property damage. He said that ozone smog also inhibited plant growth and can cause widespread damage to crops and forests. He said anyone who engaged in strenuous outdoor activities from jogging to manual labour—may suffer smog-related health effects. He said physical activity caused people to breathe faster and more deeply, exposing their lungs to more ozone and other pollutants. He said active children run the highest risks from exposure to smog, as children spent a lot of time playing outside. He said as group, children were also more prone to asthma—the most common chronic disease for children—and other respiratory ailments, than adults. He said similarly, worked adults of any age who exercised or worked outdoors were considered at higher risk from smog. He said people with asthma or other chronic respiratory diseases were more sensitive and vulnerable to the effects of ozone.
