.. due to distance, language difficulties

The Chairman of the Council of Leather Exports, Mukhtarul Amin while addressing the Buyer-seller Meet at the convention centre, Crown Plaza Santiago, Chile said that Latin America due to distance and language difficulties remained largely unexplored by the Indian leather sector. He said due to the endeavours of the Indian government and its continuous encouragement and infrastructural advancements, the leather sector was taking an increasingly positive interest towards enhancing trade tie ups with the Latin American countries (LAC).

He said the leather sector had grown from being a traditional, rural and artisan based, inward looking industry to subsequently emerge as a modern, sophisticated, outward

looking sector making world class products for leading life style brands across the world.

He said Latin America had been identified as a focus market for the Government of India due to the large untapped

potential for enhancing trade and other forms of collaboration between India and Latin America for mutual benefit. India exports leather and leather products worth US\$ 100 million to Latin American countries, out of which around

50% goes to Chile. Chile ranks first among LAC countries as significant importer of leather, leather products and footwear with imports at US\$ 1150 Mn in 2016 and imports around US\$ 1 billion worth of footwear, thus Chile was a potential market for footwear.

Lecture on environment protection awareness

KANPUR: The Scientific Officer, Uttar Pradesh Pollution Control Board, Dr Chitra Srivastava, while delivering a lecture on 'Environment Protection Awareness: Need of the Hour' at the Christ Church College on Tuesday said it was encouraging of the Chemistry Department of the College to focus on a vital subject in the current times. She said environmental pollution referred to the introduction of harmful pollutants into the environment which had hazardous impact not only on the world but on the living beings as well. She said today both flora and fauna were dangerously threatened engendering the need for not only awareness on pollution but on protection as well. She said much rested on the shoulders of policy makers of the country. She said awareness about environment was meant to help social groups and individuals to acquire a basic understanding of environment and its associated problems. She said educationists and environmental specialists had repeatedly pointed out that any solution to the environmental crisis will require environmental awareness and understanding to be deeply rooted in the education system at all levels. She said the aim

was to create a collective action in solving the environmental problems. The new types of complex environmental problems required understanding and hence a new approach should be relevant with regard to being able to fulfill established environmental objectives. She said there was an urgent need to safeguard the environment to save the future generation as it required understanding the immediate and real needs of UDCs by initiating a local process through adult education programmes. She said it meant environmental awareness by promoting low-cost resources conservation, regeneration of eco-system of villages and stimulation of environmentally sound surroundings. She said apart from this there was a need for creating awareness through mass-media

Dr Srivastava said the goal should be to focus certain relative aspects leading to environmental protection through conservation emphasising the protection of good earth and thus there was a need to promote different methodologies of oil conservation since the electronic media were a potential mobiliser of public opinion. She added that environmental pollution had existed for cen-

turies but only started to be significant following the industrial revolution. She said pollution occurred when the natural environment cannot destroy an element without creating harm or damage to itself. She said the elements involved were not produced by nature, and the destroying process can vary from a few days to thousands of years.

She said pollution must be taken seriously, as it had a negative effect on natural elements that were an absolute need for life to exist on earth, such as water and air. She said
