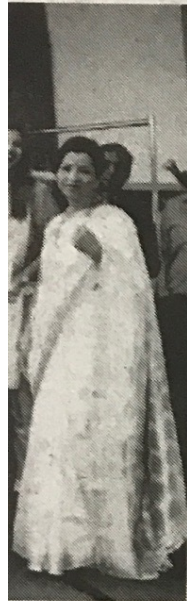

## Shopkeeper electrocuted

A shopkeeper was electrocuted near Bajarja police station after he came in contact with the electric current flowing in a wall from the underground cable on Saturday morning. Local residents immediately staged massive agitation on the Bakarmandi slope and blocked the road alleging the lackadaisical attitude of KESCO. It may be recalled that the work of laying underground cable by private company is on in the city at different places. After laying the cable at some of the places, KESCO had restored the power supply. In the Bakarmandi

area, the power supply was being made through the underground cable which, owing to heavy downpour, created havoc for the residents. On Saturday morning, Suresh Sonkar (50) of Colonelganj Katikana, Bajarja, was present at his shop. Around 11 am, suddenly the electric current from underground cable started flowing in the shop wall which led to the killing of Suresh. Local police made efforts to pacify the issue but kin of the deceased continued to demand payment of compensation. Due to massive jam on Bakarmandi slope, the movement of traffic from both the sides was disrupted for several hours.
