## STF nabs three criminals in city to kill BJP MLA

Varanasi unit of Special Task Force (STF) got major success when it nabbed a criminal carrying reward and his two aides when they were in city to kill BJP MLA from Syedraja in Chandauli Sushil Singh. Three pistols, five live cartridges and three mobile handsets were recovered from their possessions. According to information, the STF got information that the hardcore criminal Shivprakash Tiwari aka Dhoni Tiwari of Basti, carrying cash reward of Rs 1 lakh on his head and wanted in the murder of state convener of Hindu Yuva Vahini BD Ojha on July 25, 2011 in Basti, was in city to commit a heinous crime. The SP, STF, Varanasi Amit Kumar constituted a team under the leadership of Inspector Amit Srivastava to collect information about him.

At night on Friday last, the team got tip-off about the presence of criminal Shivprakash Tiwari near a gas agency in

Taktakpur, under the Cantt police station. Acting on information, a team of STF comprising Inspectors Amit Srivastava, Vipin Kumar Rai, Shailesh Pratap Singh and Punit Parihar raided the place.

When the team tried to nab the criminals they opened fire but after brief encounter, the team succeeded in nabbing Shivprakash Tiwari and his two aides Manish Kesarwani of Prayagraj and Anjani Singh of Prayagraj Manish Kesarwani and Anjani Singh and also recovered one pistol of 32 bore, three live cartridges of 32 bore, two pistol of 315 bore, two live cartridges of 315 bore and three mobile handsets from their possessions. During interrogation, Shivprakash Tiwari informed that as Amarnath Chaubey of Srikanthpur, under the Chaubeypur police station had made arrangement of places in Hajipur and Patna in Bihar for him to take shelter after committing crime and thus, on his instruction, he along with Manish and Anjani

was in city to kill BJP MLA from Syedraja in Chandauli Sushil Singh, Ajay Mardah and Sunny Singh. But before he could succeed, the STF team rounded him up. During the interrogation, Shivprakash Tiwari confessed his involvement in the murder of state convener of Hindu Yuva Vahni BD Ojha in Basti and also in other criminal incidents. The other criminals also confessed their involvement in criminal incidents in Prayagraj. The STF team informed that Shivprakash Tiwari was absconding since the court had given life imprisonment with five others in murder case of Ojha in 2018.

## Illicit arms recovered

Huge cache of illicit arms were recovered and two persons were arrested in a joint operation of Swat team of Prayagraj and Ghoorpur police on Friday night following a raid at a hideout in the mountainous terrain of Iradatganj.

The police was on a routine vehicle checking drive when they received a tip from an informer that an illicit arms factory was running under the roof of a tent situated 100 metres before the Sujawan Dev triangular crossing near the mountainous terrain.

Following a tip-off, the Swat team and the Ghoorpur

police reached there and raided the place. The miscreants were caught unawares and had to surrender with any resistance. Police arrested two persons Chandrabali Pasi, son of Harish Pasi and Sant Lal Vishwakarma, son of Budai Lal, both residents off Karchana. Police said that both the arrested persons were historysheeters and were wanted by the police in a number of offences.

Besides equipment used in the manufacture of illicit arms, the police recovered huge cache of arms including four pistols of .32 bore, eight pistols of .315 bore, two pistols of .12 bore and a number of unfinished pistols.
