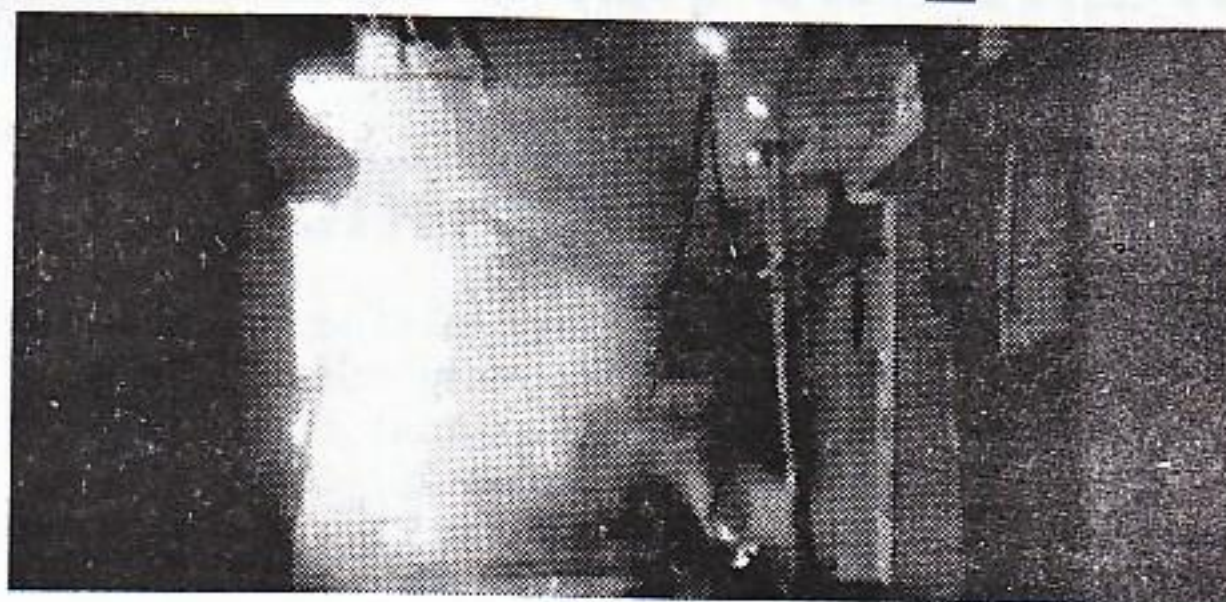

# Fire breaks out in hosiery goods shop

KANPUR: Property and goods worth lakhs of rupees were gutted in the fire which broke out in a wholesale hosiery goods shop in densely populated lane of Maniram Bagia, under the Moolganj police station late on Sunday night. Fire brigade along with local police reached the spot and controlled the flames after vigorous efforts. According to reports, late on Sunday night, residents of hosiery market in Maniram Bagia saw the flames coming out of the shop of Randhir Hosiery. They immediately informed the shop owner, fire brigade and police. During the rescue operation, fire fighting jawans had to face a tough time in extinguishing the flames being the spot situated in a narrow lane. The cause of incident could not be ascertained.
