Cantt Board approves renewal of leases

Kanpur (PNS): The Cantonment Board has given a green signal for renewal of leases pending in the Cantonment area. In a meeting, it was decided that the lease shall be effective for three years from the current date. The lease renewal fees will be from Rs 100 to less than Rs 1000. It has also allowed Shantinagar Dharamshala to be run by the same organisation but cautioned it against being used for wedding and other functions except religious functions.

It was also decided that the amount to be fixed for the allotment shall be fixed in the next meeting of the Cantonment Board. The meeting was chaired by Brigadier Navin Singh, and attended by CEO Naveen Dwivedi, Lakhn Omar and Adm Commandant AK Rai.

The meeting also decided to fell eight trees that are hindering construction of the new Golaghat Bridge. The Cantonment Board has given tender for cleaning on one per cent profit instead of 18 per cent. Besides, the maintenance of five tubewells has also been given on contract for two years.

The Cantonment Board has decided to appoint graders and fill up other pending vacancies and also open PM Jan Aushadhi Kendra in Faithfulganj.
